## Tickets now on sale for Harvestin' dinner

Home-grown Prince Edward County foods are moving from the rural roads to Main Street Monday, Aug. 24.

That afternoon from 5-8 p.m. the County's economic development office in partnership with local producers will stage the Harvestin' Supper in Picton.

The fourth annual event offers a full meal prepared from local ingredients in the middle of the street. Last year in

Wellington, more than 1,000 people were fed. Bloomfield and Milford have also hosted.

Tickets are \$20 and children under six eat free, but get them quickly as last year, the meal sold out quickly. They're available for purchase now at Campbell's Orchards, Taste the County, Hick's General Store, the County Farm Centre, and Sobeys.
